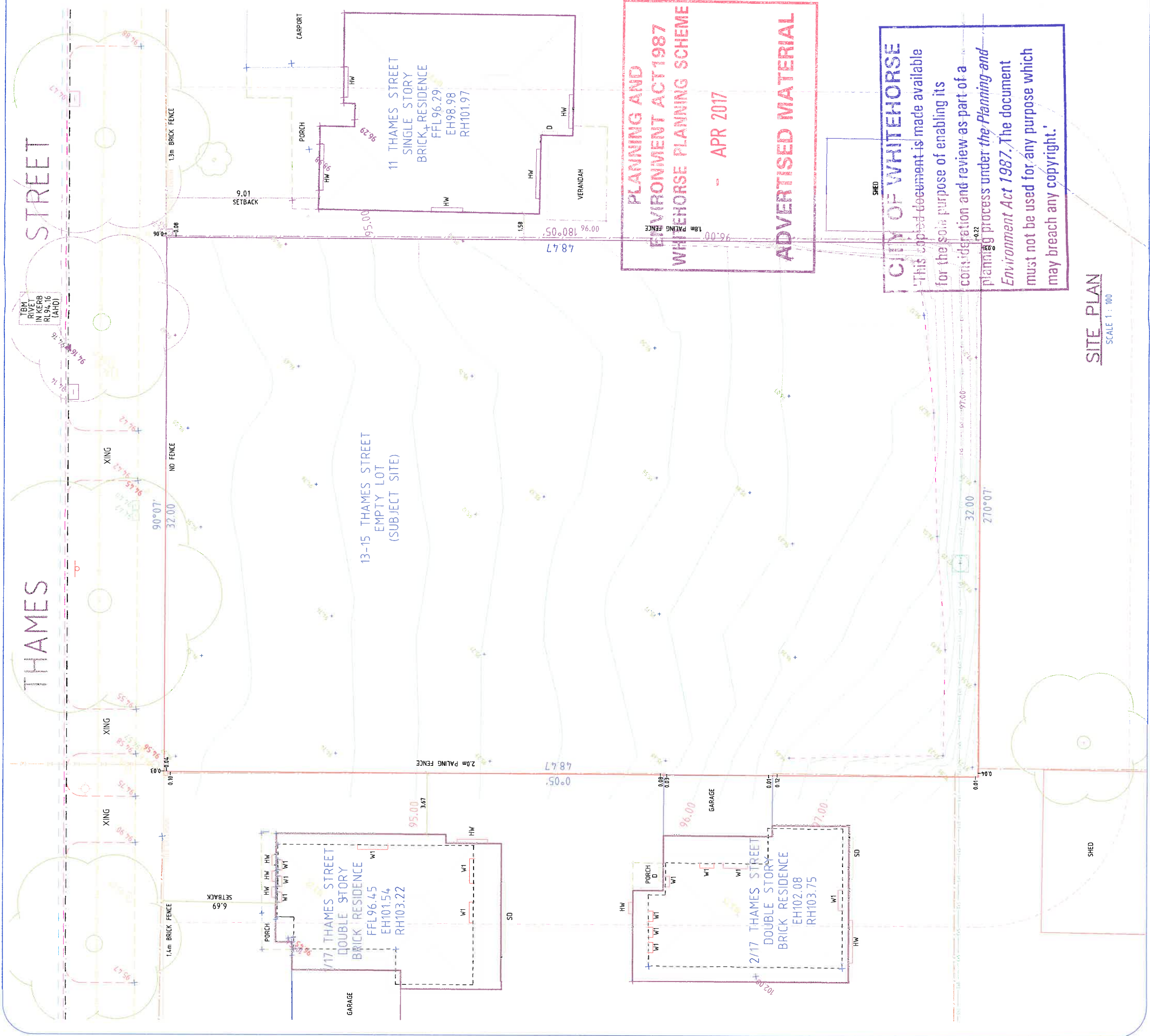




SITE PLAN

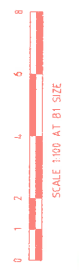

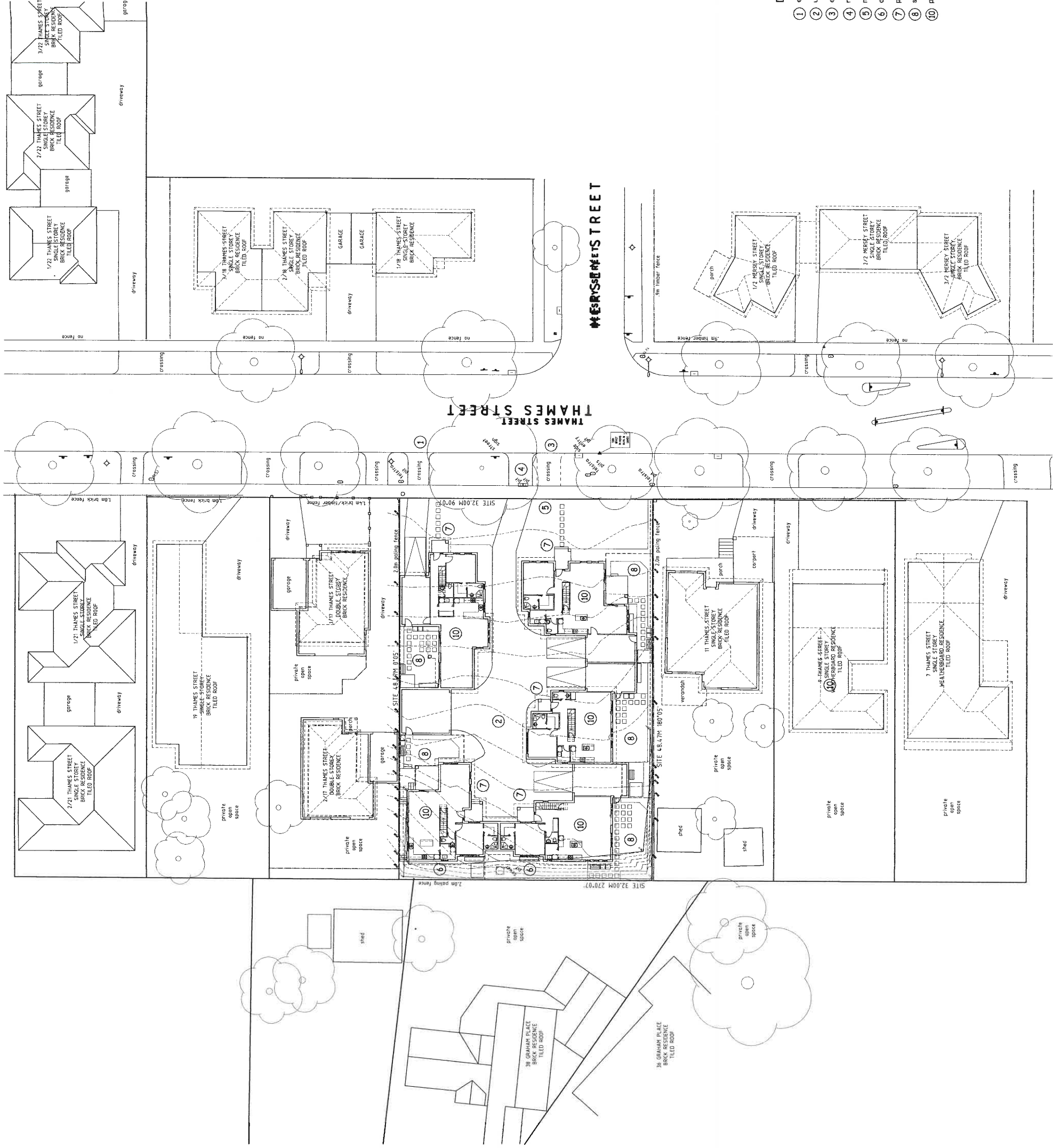

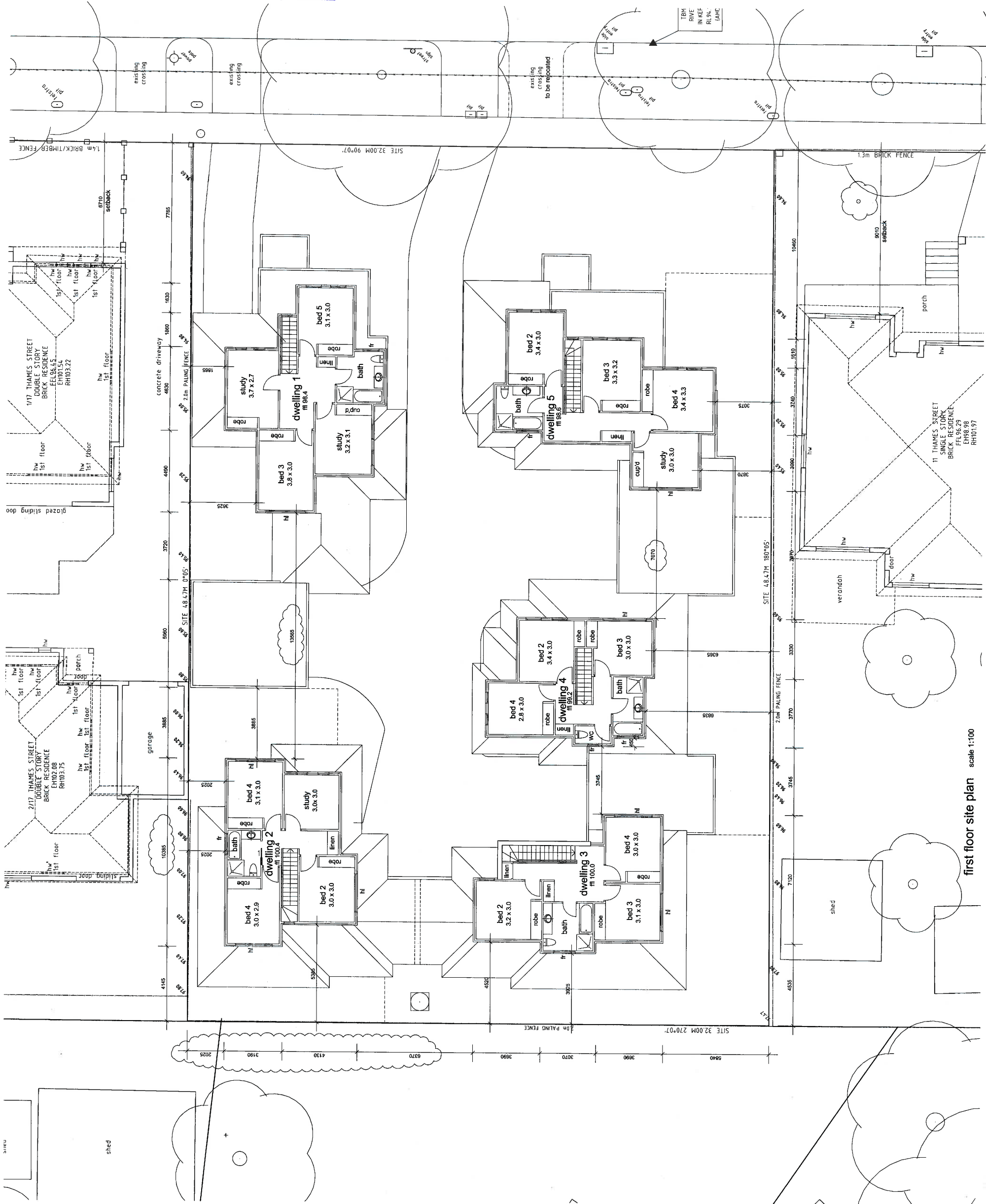
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Design Response:

- existing driveway relocated
- new driveway relocated around street tree, street sign and existing pits
- no front fence proposed
- dwellings located with minimum 1.0m clearance from edge of sewer pipe and sewer pit
- proposed dwellings each have their own distinctive and clearly identifiable entries
- secluded private open spaces all have access to northerly sunlight and are located directly off-lying areas
- proposed materials - brickwork, render & tiled roof respects the neighbourhood character

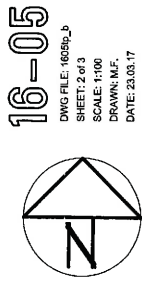




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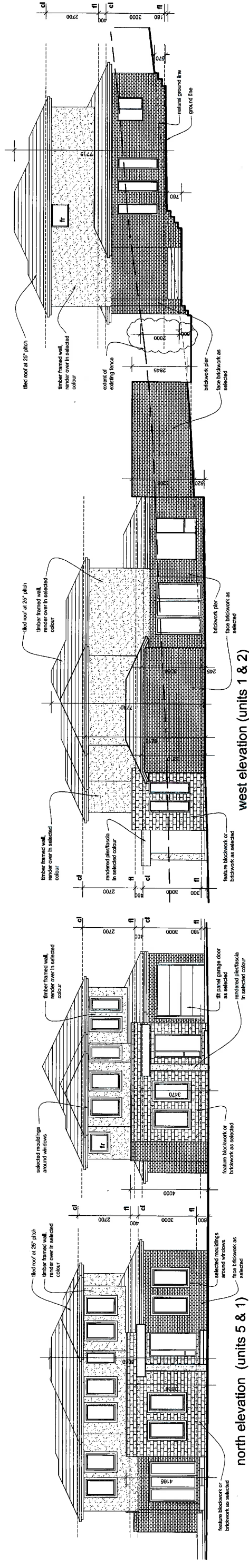

Specifications

Subgrade preparation
Site preparation to be carried out in accordance with best horticultural practice and under suitable conditions. Disturbance to indigenous soil structure is to be minimised. The use of machinery that may damage soil structure or profile is not acceptable. Sub-grade to all lawn and planted areas is to be established to a minimum depth of 300mm and shaped to achieve the desired level and drainage. The sub-grade to be established to a minimum depth of 300mm. Proposed topsoil areas to be graded / finished to prevent water discharge into neighbouring properties.

Weed control
Remove and dispose of environmental weeds off site prior to subgrade preparation, topsoiling and planting works.

Soil Preparation
Topsoil is to be spread to a maximum 30mm layer, lightly compacted by use of a 200 x 200mm roller, or by thoroughly walking until it accords with finished level or to within 75mm below existing levels to accommodate mulch. Plant Establishment Period
All existing vegetation shown on the site plan (subject to size and neighbouring properties) is to be retained (including demolition) and protected by a 1.8m high timber post and rail fence. An in-ground automatic drip irrigation system is to be installed for all garden areas and planter boxes (if applicable) in accordance with current local watering regulations.

Timber Edging
Timber edging to be 75mm x 100mm treated pine secured to ground using treated pine stakes at 1m intervals. Edging to be installed to all garden areas and planter boxes (if applicable) in accordance with current local watering regulations.

Drainage
Landscaping and/or building contractors are responsible for civil and hydraulic computations for landscape building works including, but not limited to surface and sub surface drainage for garden beds, lawns and topsoiling / pabble areas.

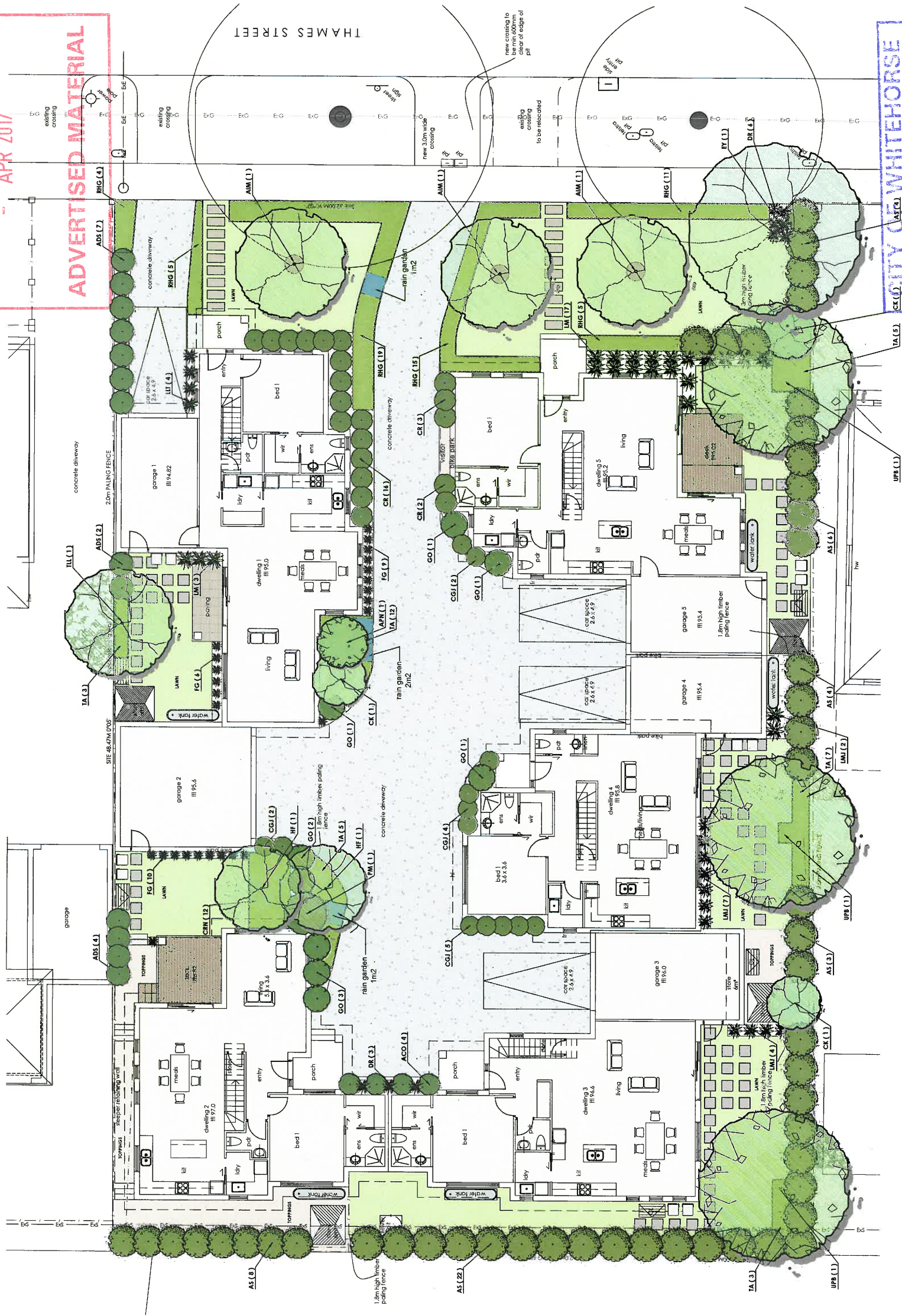

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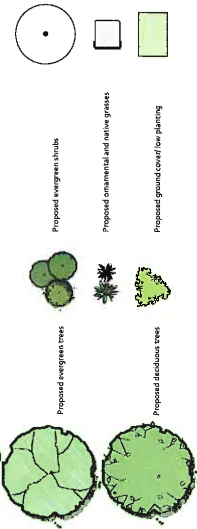


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Surface Finishes Detail

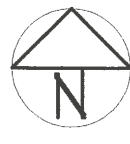
